17 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business  
18 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San  
19 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 20  
20 off-sale beer and wine license from 566 Minnesota Street to 101-4th Street to Beth

23 Conditions: (1) Sales and service of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted

25 Years Eve, sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted from 8:00 am to 12:00 am

1 and on the day after Thanksgiving, the day before Christmas and the day after  
2 Christmas, sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted from 6:00 am to 12:00 am.  
3 (2) No more than 5% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display  
4 of alcoholic beverages. (3) No malt beverage shall be sold with an alcoholic content  
5 great than 5.7% by volume, except for microbrews, craft brews, organic, and specialty  
6 malt products sold under such designations as stout, porter, IPA, and ESB. This  
7 condition is intended to eliminate high alcohol, low-cost products that are frequently  
8 abused, but not prevent the sales of specialty and craft beer products. (4) The sale of  
9 beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 22 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size  
10 containers is prohibited. (5) No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of  
11 less than manufacturer pre-packaged four packs per sale. No wine-coolers or beer  
12 coolers shall be sold in less than manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four  
13 (4). (6) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater than 15% by volume  
14 except for "Dinner Wines", which have been aged two years or more and maintained in  
15 corked bottles. (8) Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml.  
16 unless sold in manufacturer's prepackaged multi-unit quantities.

Target Corporation ("Target") has applied to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for a Type 20 Off-Sale Beer and Wine license at the new CityTarget store, opening in the San Francisco Metreon Centre later this year. Because the new store is located in a census tract that has an "undue concentration" of off-sale licenses under Section 23958.4 of the Business and Professions Code, Target is requesting a determination by the Board of Supervisors that public convenience or necessity will be served by issuance of the license.

Target has applied for a person-to-person, premises-to-premises transfer of an existing Type 20 license to its new store location in the San Francisco Metreon Centre at the corner of Fourth Street and Mission Street. The new 100,000 square-foot store will occupy the entire second floor of the Metreon and will employ approximately 250 team members. The store hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 11 p.m. Monday – Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 10 p.m. Sunday, with extended store hours during the holiday season.

The new store will be one of the first CityTargets in California. The new-format CityTarget stores are smaller in size than a traditional Target store and designed specifically to meet the needs of urban residents and visitors. The San Francisco CityTarget, centrally located in downtown San Francisco, will provide commuters, tourists and nearby residents the convenience of one-stop shopping for urban living essentials.

A significant component of CityTarget will be its grocery section. CityTarget will offer a full-range of grocery products, including fresh meats, fresh vegetables and produce and fresh bakery items, along with a selection of dry goods. Along with its grocery offerings, Target would like to be able to offer customers the ability to purchase beer and wine. Adding beer and wine to its grocery offerings will provide downtown residents (as well as commuters doing their home shopping downtown) with a convenient, one stop-destination for grocery and beverage purchases.

Beth Aboulafia, on behalf of Target Corporation, has filed an application with the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control seeking a Type 20 (Off-Sale Beer and Wine-Store) license for 101 Fourth Street, located next to the northeast corner of Mission Street and Forth Street. City Target will be inside the Metreon, San Francisco, a commercial space with numerous retail establishments and eateries.

It should be noted that during the application process, notification date for the 500' mailer was on May 10, 2011. The Notice to the Public was posted on May 9, 2011.

For the purposes of this hearing, the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) seeks a determination from the Board of Supervisors as to the approval or denial of this license.

2. No more than 5% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages.

3. No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257.
4. No malt beverage shall be sold with an alcoholic content great than 5.7% by volume.
5. The sales of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 22 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers are prohibited.
6. No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than manufacturer pre-packaged six packs per sale with the exception of wine-coolers, beer coolers which must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more.
7. No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of great than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles.
8. Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml.

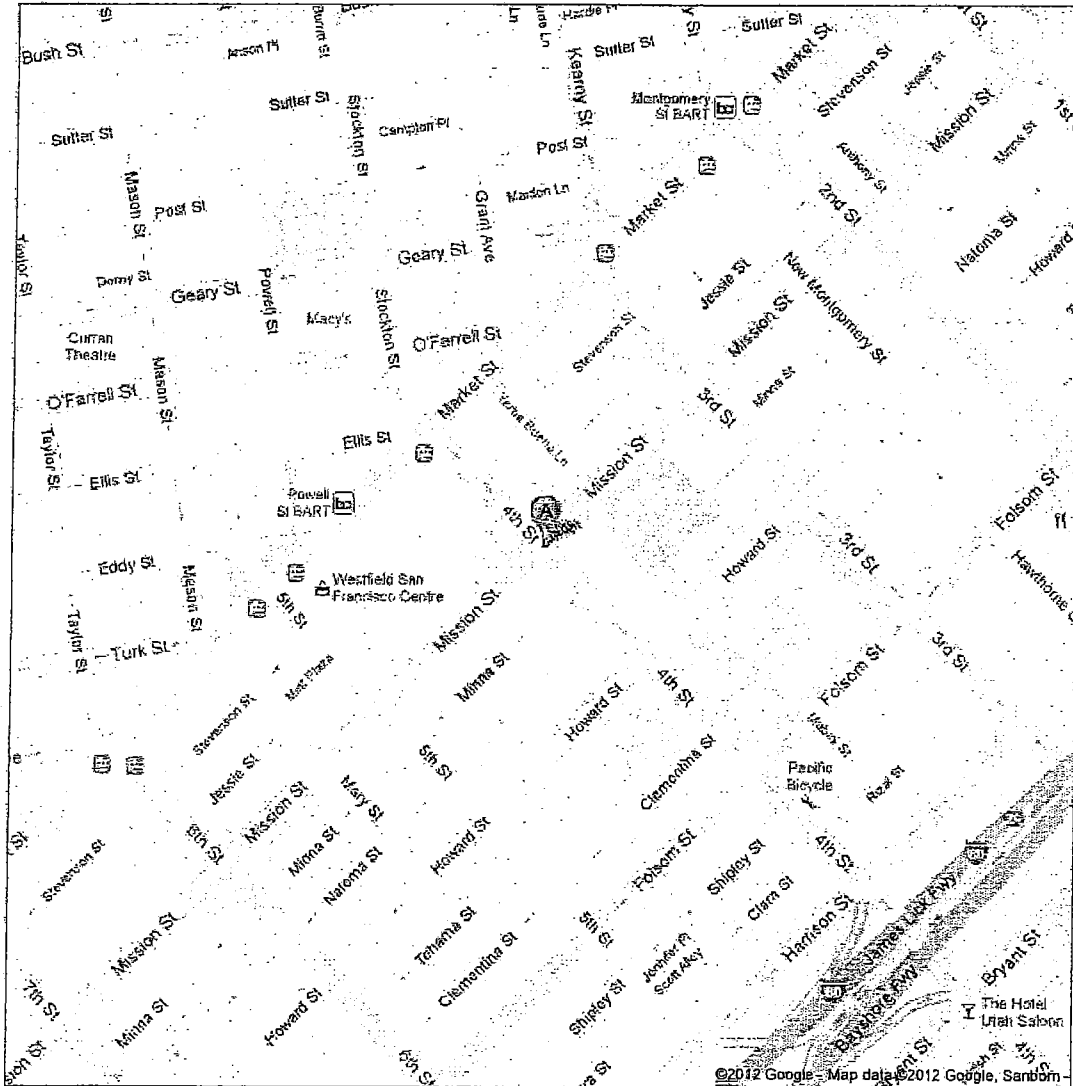

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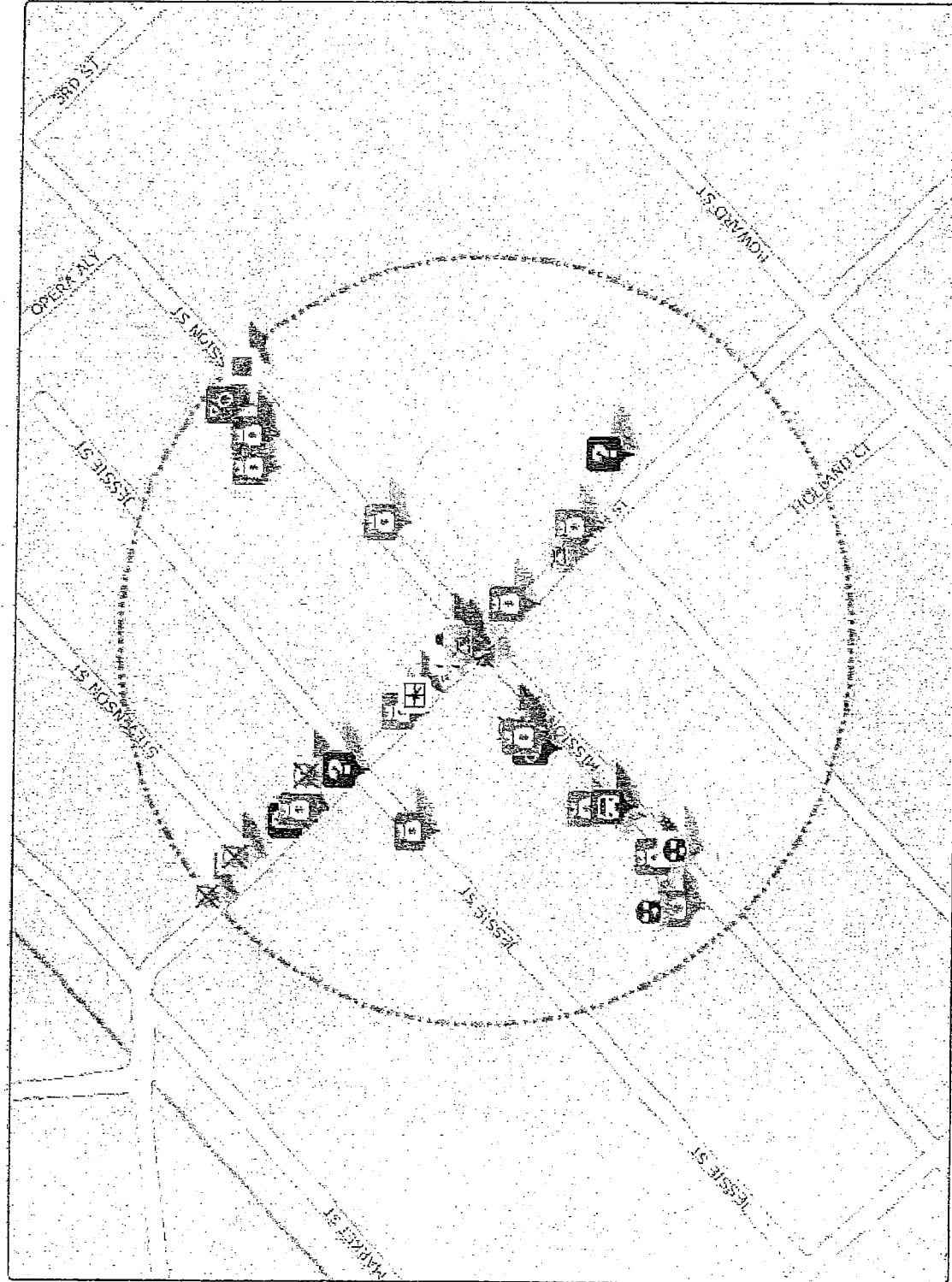

After surveying the area around the new Target store and talking with both security, nearby residents and merchants about the effects a large chain store would have in retailing any forms of liquor to the public in the manner of a off-sale license.

Nearby merchants express the lower price point the a large retailer can sell their liquor at which would take away customers of already existing smaller established community serving stores. Local residents have the same concerns that a retailer such as Target can offer lower priced liquor which nearby already established licensed stores would have a hard time competing against. There is a strong support of local retailers to stay in business and to maintain their existing stores and customer base. We do want to see more smaller stores closing because of their lose of revenue.

The main concern residents and security have is enforcing and protecting the already established San Francisco Park Code for Yerba Buena Gardens (a copy of rules are attached as page 3). This code specially mentions smoking and alcoholic beverages which are intended to be sold by Target. Additional concerns by security is the drain on public resources in dealing with shoplifters. The San Francisco Police Department continues to shrink in the number of officers. And San Francisco continues to increase in population bringing more security tasks to perform with fewer police officers.

The next concern is Yerba Buena Gardens itself. Open Space with the following consideration points Ice Skating Center, Play Circle, Bowling Center, Child Development Center, and Carousel; several adjacent parking garages and facilities; and St. Patrick's Church. (a copy of map are attached as page 4)

Issuance of the license to the premises would add an undue concentration of licenses; licensing the premises aggravates an already existing police problems in a high-crime area; and the premises is within 500 feet of open space.

I do not know what the security plan for the new store is nor do I know which exists will be used by the public.

Because of the above concerns the following conditions must be applied.

Employees of the establishment shall walk a 100 feet radius from the premises sometime between 30 minutes after closing time and 8AM the following morning and shall pick up and dispose of any discarded beverage containers and other trash left by patrons.

The establishment shall provide outside lighting in a manner sufficient to illuminate street and adjacent sidewalk areas and parking as appropriate to maintain security.

No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any outdoor property adjacent to the establishment.

No person under the age of 21 shall sell or package alcoholic beverages.

Employees of the establishment shall regularly police the area under the control of the establishment in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons about the premises.

The establishment shall promptly remove any graffiti from the exterior of the premises.

Proper signage at all exists informing patrons of the San Francisco Park Code for Yerba Buena Gardens.

Sales of Alcohol only permitted between the hours of 8AM to 10PM 7 days a week.

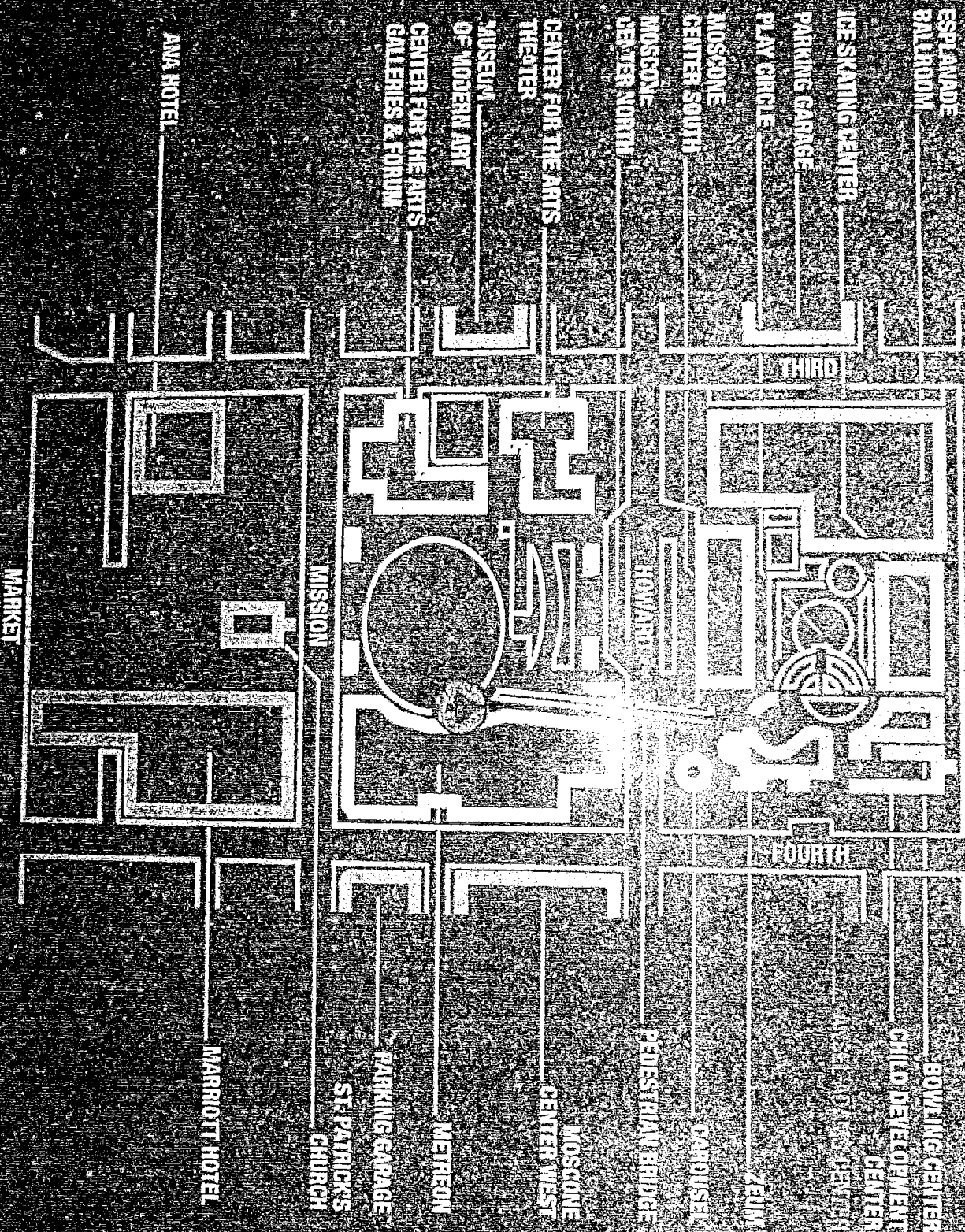
