3 **Resolution urging the San Francisco Unified School District and Lowell High School to**
4 **close the Meadowbrook entrance to Lowell's campus on weekends, and, alternatively,**
5 **to use either the Winston Avenue entrance or Lake Merced Boulevard entrance to the**
6 **campus.**

8 WHEREAS, Lowell High School has multiple driveway entrances to its campus,
9 including entrances from Meadowbrook, Winston Avenue, and Lake Merced Boulevard; and,

10 WHEREAS, On weekends, the only route of access to the campus open to the public
11 is the one located at the intersection of Meadowbrook and Eucalyptus Drive; and,

12 WHEREAS, This entrance is used by many drivers accessing Lowell's basketball and
13 tennis courts on the weekends; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a result of this heavy traffic, the surrounding neighborhood is
15 experiencing traffic congestion and unnecessary noise; and,

16 WHEREAS, The traffic congestion poses a pedestrian safety threat to the neighbors
17 near and around Lowell's campus; and,

18 WHEREAS, There are two other entrances to the Lowell campus, on Winston Avenue
19 and on Lake Merced Boulevard, that are currently closed but could be opened as a route of
20 access to the basketball and tennis courts; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
22 urges the San Francisco Unified School District and Lowell High School to close the
23 Meadowbrook entrance to Lowell's campus on weekends, and, alternatively, to use either the
24 Winston Avenue entrance or Lake Merced Boulevard entrance to the campus.


