WHEREAS, This entrance is used by many drivers accessing Lowell's basketball and tennis courts on the weekends; and,

WHEREAS, As a result of this heavy traffic, the surrounding neighborhood is experiencing traffic congestion and unnecessary noise; and,

WHEREAS, The traffic congestion poses a pedestrian safety threat to the neighbors near and around Lowell's campus; and,

WHEREAS, There are two other entrances to the Lowell campus, on Winston Avenue and on Lake Merced Boulevard, that are currently closed but could be opened as a route of access to the basketball and tennis courts; now, therefore, be it
