11	Section 1. The San Francisco Building Code is hereby amended by adding Section
12	104.6, to read as follows:

14	Sec. 104.6.1 Definitions. For the purposes of this section, the following definitions shall
15	<u>apply:</u>
16	DEDICATED TELEPHONE NUMBER means a telephone number for a recorded message in a
17	Language of Limited English Proficient Residents. The recorded message shall advise callers as to
18	what information they should leave on the message machine so that the Department may return the cal
19	with information about the notice in the requested language.
20	LANGUAGE OF LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENT RESIDENTS means each of the five
21	languages other than English spoken most commonly by San Francisco residents as determined by the
22	Planning Department based on its annual review of United States census and other data as required by
23	San Francisco Administrative Code Section 91.2(j).
24	Sec. 104.6.2 Applicability of Multiple Language Requirement. The requirements of Section
25	104.6.3 shall apply to the following notices:

11	a cover sheet as specified below and include it with each notice of the type listed in Section 104.6.2 that
12	is mailed or personally served. For posted notices listed in Section 104.6.2, the Department shall post
13	the cover sheet next to the posted notice. The cover sheet shall contain the following statement, printed
14	in each Language of Limited English Proficient Residents, with the appropriate information inserted in
15	the blank spaces as to the Building Code Section that requires the notice, the address of the property
16	that gives rise to the notice, the time period for a decision on the matter, the name of the language in
17	which the statement is made and the Dedicated Telephone Number for the language of the statement:
18	"This notice is provided under Building Code Section It concerns

7	306.10 to read as follows:
8	SEC. 306.10. MULTIPLE LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT FOR NOTICES. (a)
9	Applicability. In addition to the notice requirements set forth elsewhere in this Code, the requirements
10	of this section shall apply to the mailed notices that are required by the following sections of the
11	Planning Code: Sections 228.4(c), 304.5(d), 306.3, 306.7(g), 306.9(c), 309(c) through 309(h), 311,
12	312,, 313.4(b), 314.4(a), 316.3(d), 330.7, and any other section of the Planning Code that requires a
13	notice to be mailed or personally served to property owners or occupants adjacent to or near a
14	property for which Planning Department development approval is sought.
15	(b) Definitions. The following definitions shall apply for the purposes of this section:
16	(1) Dedicated Telephone Number means a telephone number for a recorded message in a
17	Language of Limited English Proficient Residents. The recorded message shall advise callers as to
18	what information they should leave on the message machine so that the Department may return the call
19	with information about the notice in the requested language.
20	(2) Language of Limited English Proficient Residents means each of the five languages other
21	than English spoken most commonly by San Francisco residents as determined by the Planning
22	Department based on its annual review of United States census and other data as required by San
23	Francisco Administrative Code Section 91.2(j).
24	(c) Multiple Language Statement in Notices. The Planning Department shall prepare a
25	cover sheet as specified below and include it with each notice of the type listed in subsection (a). The

1	cover sheet shall contain the following statement, printed in each Language of Limited English
2	Proficient Residents, with the appropriate information inserted in the blank spaces as to the Planning
3	Code Section that requires the notice, the address of the property that gives rise to the notice, the time
4	period for a decision on the matter, the name of the language in which the statement is made and the
5	<u>Dedicated Telephone Number for the language of the statement:</u>
