

#### How will the \$8.4M be spent?

On September 22, Mayor Breed announced the release of \$8.4 million unspent and unallocated SSF to support SFUSD through the School Stabilization Team. DCYF will administer these dollars according to the intent of the SSF, including but not limited to the following:

- Address emergency needs (e.g. address nonfoundational/core staffing)
- Bolster SFUSD capacity (e.g. communications and/or operational support)
- Resource emergent strategies to support schools (e.g. transition planning and support for students and families in the event of school closures)

### Will the \$8.4M allocated to the School Stabilization Team impact the availability of SSF funding to SFUSD?

The \$8.4M released for the School Stabilization Team does not impact SSF funding available to SFUSD. There are no reductions to current or future SSF funding to SFUSD school sites' grants.

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
