WHEREAS, Dean Zain Azzghayer is seeking the issuance of a Type 21 off-sale general license for Dean's, located at 450-460 Powell Street; and,

WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 21 off-sale general license to Dean Zain Azzghayer for Dean's, located at 450-460 Powell Street, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

Conditions: (1) Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. each day of the week. (2) From the hours of 10 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. all entrance/exit points onto Powell Street shall be secured and used

only in the event of an emergency. The sales of alcoholic beverages during this time period shall be made only to those customers who enter/exit the premises through the door located in the interior lobby of the Sir Francis Drake Hotel (450 Powell Street). (3) No alcoholic beverage shall be sold with a net retail price of less than twenty U.S. Dollars (\$20.00) per unit. Unit is defined as an individual single alcoholic beverage or a single manufacturer's pre-packaged multi-unit. The twenty dollar (\$20.00) unit price shall be subject to no more than a 2% (simple interest) annual increase for each year from the date of signature of the ABC-172. This increase can be applied at the discretion of the Department. (4) The sale of beer or malt beverages is strictly prohibited. (5) No person under the age of 21 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages. (6) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corded bottles. (7) Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml. Except for manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more. (8) No distilled spirits shall be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 375 ml (corresponds to 4/5 pint). (9) There shall be no cups, glasses, or similar receptacles commonly used for the drinking of beverages, sold, furnished, or given away at the petitioner's premises in quantities of less than twelve (12) in their original multi-container package. (10) All ice shall be sold at or above prevailing prices in the area and in quantities of not less than three (3) pounds per sale and shall not be given away free. (11) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee. (12) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any

sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee.

I am currently a business consultant located at 535 Green Street between Columbus and Grant Avenues in North Beach, San Francisco. I serve on various non-profit community boards and consult many merchant and neighborhood groups in North Beach as well as Chinatown. I consult with a lobbying firm and also promote tourism. It is my opinion that there is an over-concentration of liquor licenses coupled with a high crime rate that is in District 3 and also District 6 and that a liquor license at 450 Powell Street facing and visible to the sidewalk at Powell and Sutter Streets is neither necessary or desirable at this time. No one is deprived of trying to purchase alcoholic products in this location. Additionally, we have been made fully aware of all the budget cuts and draining of police resources at Central Station. Having a liquor license at this location could possibly increase the workload and compound the economic dilemma. I walk through the area daily and often see Officer Carl Payne trying to roust vagrants who sit and lie and sleep in that vicinity and who aggressively panhandle both locals and visitors alike.

I would not be against the Sir Francis Drake having an in house wine shop that is not an outwardly visible storefront; however, this is not what they are applying for. A Type 21 out the door simply doesn't make any sense.

Subject 450 Powell Street Liquor Sales

Dear San Francisco Board of Supervisors:

I am writing this email in opposition of granting a liquor license as applied for by the owners of 450 Powell Street, San Francisco. My Name is Arthur Bossé; I am the Executive Director of the Bay Area Affiliate of the National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence. Our organization is not a temperance organization but an organization whose mission is to prevent addictive disorders through effective prevention programming and education. I firmly believe that controlling the amount of liquor sales licenses in densely populated areas is not only a public policy issue but a public health issue.

Studies indicate a clear association between a high density of alcohol distribution points and public disorder including violence, noise and disturbances, public vomiting and urination, damage and destruction to property, offensive behavior and assault and violence (Reid, Hughey & Peterson, 2003: Zhu, Gorman & Horel, 2004).

One factor that is important to the development of alcohol-related problems is the availability of alcohol. The neighborhood where this liquor store exists has too much alcohol available for sale at too many sites. Liquor can be readily obtained without much effort from any citizen that resides there completing the equation that:

Increased alcohol availability raises alcohol consumption leading to a greater risk for individuals to engage in more extreme and disruptive behaviors (Reynolds, Holder & Gruenewald, 1997).

The Board of Supervisors can prevent another liquor distribution outlet from being created by denying the Public Convenience Letter for 450 Powell Street.
