3 **Resolution commending the Old First Presbyterian Church on its 40<sup>th</sup> Year**  
4 **Anniversary, the rededication and renaming of its senior center to the “Doris Krauss**  
5 **Senior Center” and commending Doris Krauss for her 29-plus years of tireless**  
6 **dedication, commitment and overall contributions to the well-being of the senior**  
7 **population of San Francisco.**

9 WHEREAS, The Old First Presbyterian Church, in conjunction with the San Francisco  
10 Community College District and the San Francisco Council of Churches, established its  
11 Senior Center in 1963; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Old First Senior Center has served hundreds of San Francisco  
13 seniors over the past 40 years, providing them with meals and social, spiritual, and  
14 educational programs; and,

15 WHEREAS, Doris Krauss was appointed as the first permanent Director of the Senior  
16 Center in 1999 and has served in this position for the past 29 years; and,

17 WHEREAS, Doris Krauss was involved with the Northern California Presbyterian  
18 Homes, being instrumental in the planning and implementation of that organization’s San  
19 Francisco communities, which are the Sequoias, Eastern Park Apartments and Western Park  
20 Apartments; and

21 WHEREAS, Doris Krauss developed programs for spiritual and social services to  
22 residents of the Old First Senior Center and the Northern California Presbyterian Homes  
23 communities; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
25 does hereby commend the Old First Senior Center on its 40<sup>th</sup> Year Anniversary and its

1 subsequent rededication of this Center as the “Doris Krauss Senior Center” located at the Old  
2 First Presbyterian Church; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors does hereby commend Doris Kraus  
4 for her 29-plus years of tireless dedication, commitment and overall contributions to the well-  
5 being of the senior population of San Francisco.
