

1 [Raising a contract’s dollar amount to more than \$10 million.]

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3 **Resolution approving the Third Amendment to the Agreement between the City and**
4 **County of San Francisco (City) and Office Depot (Contractor) for office supplies, increasing**
5 **the Agreement’s not-to-exceed amount to more than \$10 million, pursuant to San Francisco**
6 **Charter Section 9.118(b).**

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8 WHEREAS, the City entered into an Agreement with Contractor, dated January 5, 2005,
9 for office supplies, as amended by the First Amendment, dated September 1, 2005, and the
10 Second Amendment, dated June 30, 2007; and,

11 WHEREAS, the Agreement’s not-to-exceed amount is \$10 million, and the performance
12 period is January 26, 2005 through September 1, 2007; and,

13 WHEREAS, the Purchaser and the Contractor estimate that the Agreement’s not-to-
14 exceed amount will be reached in the near future; and,

15 WHEREAS, the City and Contractor propose to enter into the Third Amendment to the
16 Agreement, which would increase the not-to-exceed amount to \$15 million and extend the
17 performance period through July 25, 2008, and the San Francisco Charter Section 9.118(b)
18 requires Board approval by Resolution for Agreements to exceed \$10 million; and

19 WHEREAS, the proposed Third Amendment is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
20 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if
21 set forth fully herein; now, therefore be it

22 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors approves the Third Amendment to the
23 Agreement, increasing the not-to-exceed amount from \$10 million to \$15 million and extending
24 the performance period through July 25, 2008.

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
