12 funding from funds made available through Senate Bill 924 (Part 3, Title 7, Chapter 5, commencing with
13 Section 6035 of the California Penal Code) the project submitted by the City and County of San Francisco
14 and referred to as the "Standards and Training of Local Corrections Program," now therefore, be it

18 Department are hereby directed to submit retroactively, to the Board of Corrections an application for and






