16	Section 1. Findings.		
17	The San Francisco Foundation has awarded the department \$50,000 to support the		
18	development of data collection tools and service standards for the new Reentry Council. The		
19	Reentry Council is a collaboration of more than 100 partners, including governmental entities		
20	and community and faith based organizations, many of them led by formerly incarcerated		
21	individuals living in San Francisco. The Reentry Council is committed to promoting a		
22	coordinated and comprehensive network of supportive services and policies that effectively		
23	and appropriately meet the needs of currently and formerly incarcerated individuals, their		
24	families, and their communities. With varying service philosophies, modalities, administrative		
25	structures, and purposes, shared standards are critical to ensuring		

1	that San Francisco is moving forward effectively, amidst or within our adversarial criminal			
2	justice system. Once completed, the Reentry Standards of Service will be adopted by			
3	City/County entities that directly provide or contract with private entities to provide reentry			
4	services.			
5	Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Funds. The Board of Supervisors			
6	hereby authorizes the Office of the Public Defender (PDR) to accept and expend a grant in			
7	the amount of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2009-2010. The grant does not include any provisions			
8	for indirect costs, and indirect costs are hereby waived.			
9	Section 3. Grant Funded Positions; Amendment to FY 2009-2010 Annual Salary
