

1 [Suspend 30 Day Rule-Resolution for Library Facilities Bonds]

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3 SUSPENDING RULE 5.40 OF THE RULES OF ORDER OF THE BOARD OF  
4 SUPERVISORS TO ALLOW THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO CONSIDER, WITHOUT  
5 WAITING 30 DAYS AFTER ITS INTRODUCTION, A RESOLUTION DETERMINING AND  
6 DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND MUNICIPAL  
7 IMPROVEMENTS CONSISTING OF THE ACQUISITION, REHABILITATION, RENOVATION,  
8 IMPROVEMENT, CONSTRUCTION OR RECONSTRUCTION BY THE CITY AND COUNTY  
9 OF SAN FRANCISCO OF LIBRARY FACILITIES AND PROPERTIES OTHER THAN THE  
10 MAIN LIBRARY, AND ALL OTHER WORKS, PROPERTY AND STRUCTURES  
11 NECESSARY OR CONVENIENT FOR THE FOREGOING PURPOSES, THAT THE  
12 ESTIMATED COST OF \$129,245,000 FOR SAID MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS IS AND  
13 WILL BE TOO GREAT TO BE PAID OUT OF THE ORDINARY ANNUAL INCOME AND  
14 REVENUE OF SAID CITY AND COUNTY AND WILL REQUIRE THE INCURRING OF A  
15 BONDED INDEBTEDNESS; FINDING THE PROPOSED PROJECT IS IN CONFORMITY  
16 WITH THE PRIORITY POLICIES OF PLANNING CODE SECTION 101.1(b) AND WITH  
17 THE GENERAL PLAN CONSISTENCY REQUIREMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
18 SECTION 2A.53.

19 WHEREAS, Rule 5.40 of the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors requires that  
20 when a measure is introduced that would create or revise major City policy, the measure shall not  
21 be considered until at least 30 days after the day of the measure's introduction;

22 WHEREAS, Rule 4.38 of the Rules of Order of the Board allows Rule 5.40 to be  
23 suspended by the affirmative vote of eight members of the Board, unless there be less than eight  
24 members present, in which case the unanimous consent of the members present, but not less than  
25 six members, shall be required;

WHEREAS, The members of the Board of Supervisors wish to suspend the operation of  
Rule 5.40 with regard to the consideration of File 001058, Library Facilities Bonds; now,  
therefore be it

1           **MOVED**, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, as  
2 allowed by Rule 4.38 of its Rules of Order, hereby suspends the operation of Rule 5.40 of its  
3 Rules of Order from operating with regard to the Board's consideration of a proposed resolution  
4 determining and declaring that the public interest and necessity demand municipal improvements  
5 consisting of the acquisition, rehabilitation, renovation, improvement, construction or  
6 reconstruction by the City and County of San Francisco of library facilities and properties other  
7 than the main library, and all other works, property and structures necessary or convenient for  
8 the foregoing purposes, that the estimated cost of \$129, 245,000 for said municipal  
9 improvements is and will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue  
10 of said City and County and will require the incurring of a bonded indebtedness; finding the  
11 proposed project is in conformity with the priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1(b)  
12 and with the general plan consistency requirement of Administrative Code Section 2A.53.


