3	Resolution authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to execute Amendment
4	No. 5 to the Contract 1000018903 with Insight Public Sector, Inc. for the purchase of
5	technology products and specialized services on an as-needed basis; increasing the
6	contract not to exceed amount of \$40,200,000 by \$3,600,000 for a total not to exceed
7	amount of \$43,800,000 effective upon approval of this Resolution, with no changes to
8	the five year contract term from January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2023.
9	
10	WHEREAS, The Amendment referenced above is substantially in the form attached
11	and are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 230906, which is hereby
12	declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein;
13	WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires the Board of Supervisors to approve by
14	Resolution contracts estimated to cost the City \$10,000,000 or more; and
15	WHEREAS, Insight Public Sector, Inc. ("Contractor") was competitively awarded the
16	Agreement through a Request for Proposals (RFP, Sourcing Event ID 0000000974) issued by
17	the Office of Contract Administration on June 20, 2018, pursuant to Administrative Code
18	Chapter 21.1, in which City selected Contractor as a qualified proposer pursuant to the RFP;
19	and
20	WHEREAS, The Contractor was one of 29 Proposers selected pursuant to the RFP,
21	which resulted in three tiers of contractors; and
22	WHEREAS, The contracts awarded pursuant to the RFP are part of the City's
23	Technology Marketplace (previously known at the "Computer Store") which originated in the
24	1990's as an efficient purchasing model for the City's evolving technology needs; and

1	WHEREAS, The Technology Marketplace contracts provide an efficient purchasing
2	model City departments to purchase technology goods and services on an as-needed basis
3	based on departments' specific business needs and reduces the amount of time needed to
4	complete a transaction from several months to 1-2 weeks; and
5	WHEREAS, All Technology Marketplace transactions above established thresholds
6	must be competitively solicited to all Technology Marketplace contractors within their
7	respective tiers and 88% of the total amount awarded to Contractor through the Technology
8	Marketplace process was awarded pursuant to a solicitation; and
9	WHEREAS, The Local Business Entity ("LBE") subcontracting participation
10	requirement for the Agreement is 15% of the total value of professional services awarded to
11	the Contractor and 10% of the total value of training services awarded to the Contractor; and
12	WHEREAS, The Civil Services approval of this Agreement has been granted under File
13	No. 44114-17/18; and
14	WHEREAS, The Agreement commenced on January 1, 2019, with an initial term of
15	three years through December 31, 2021; and
16	WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement increased the not to exceed amount
17	from \$20,000,000 to \$28,000,000 (File 200938); and
18	WHEREAS, Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement extended the Agreement end date by
19	two years to December 31, 2023, which extension did not require approval by the Board of
20	Supervisors; and
21	WHEREAS, Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement increased the not to exceed amount
22	from \$28,000,000 to \$39,700,000 (File 220177); and
23	WHEREAS, Amendment No. 4 to the Agreement increased the not to exceed amount
24	from \$39,700,000 to \$40,200,000, which increase did not require approval by the Board of
25	Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Purchaser and Director of
the Office of Contract Administration to execute Amendment No. 5 to Contract 1000018903
with Insight Public Sector, Inc. for the purchase of technology products and specialized
services on an as-needed basis; increasing the contract not to exceed amount of \$40.2 million
by \$3.6 million, for a total not to exceed (NTE) amount of \$43.8 million, for a total contract
duration of five years starting January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2023; and, be it
FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the contract being fully executed by all
parties, the Purchaser and Director of the Office of Contract Administration shall provide the
final contract to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
