During discussion on this item, youth commissioners also voted to attach the following comments and recommendations regarding this legislation:

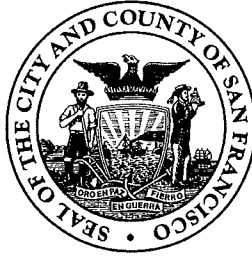
