13	(a) Prior to the adoption by the Board of Supervisors of any regulation that affects		
14	the stopping, moving, or parking of a motor vehicle pursuant to the provisions of this Code or		
15	the California Vehicle Code, notice of the proposed regulation shall be posted by the		
16	Department of Parking and Traffic in the affected neighborhood. The notice shall be posted or		
17	at least two utility poles in the affected neighborhood for no less than 14 days prior to the		
18	public hearing by a standing committee of the Board of Supervisors to consider the proposed		
19	traffic regulation.		
20	Notice of the proposed traffic regulation and the public hearing shall be published in the official		
21	newspaper of the City and County at least 10 days before the hearing date. The notice shall clearly		
22	state the purpose of the hearing and list the locations and the traffic regulation proposed for each
