

1 [Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement - County Assessors Technology Improvements Funding
2 - Up to \$30,000,000]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Assessor to enter into a Joint Exercise of Powers**
4 **Agreement with other California counties to become a member of the California County**
5 **Assessors' Information Technology Authority to receive, manage, and expend up to**
6 **\$30,000,000 of State funds for technology improvements for County Assessor Offices.**

8 WHEREAS, Section 95.60 was added to the California Revenue and Taxation Code in
9 2022 providing funding for County Assessors for technology investment for property
10 assessments; and

11 WHEREAS, Section 95.60 provides that funding must be provided to a joint powers
12 authority; and

13 WHEREAS, The fiscal year 2022-2023 budget of the State of California includes
14 \$10,000,000 to be disbursed to and managed and expended by a joint powers authority
15 comprised of California counties on behalf of their respective Assessor Offices; and

16 WHEREAS, There is a commitment for an additional \$10,000,000 from the State of
17 California in funding in the next two budget years for a total of \$30,000,000; and

18 WHEREAS, State of California property tax programs require the cooperation of county
19 assessors throughout the State to certify and share property value information statewide; and

20 WHEREAS, The funds are for the creation of technology improvements of statewide
21 application for County Assessor Offices; and

22 WHEREAS, San Francisco City and County's participation in the joint powers authority
23 is vital to effectively work with other county assessors throughout the State; and

1 WHEREAS, A copy of the nearly final joint exercise of powers agreement is on file with
2 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 230234; and

3 WHEREAS, On November 15, 2022, Alameda County and Kings County formed the
4 California County Assessors' Information Technology Authority which now has 21 other
5 counties as members; and

6 WHEREAS, The joint powers authority will be managed by a board of directors
7 consisting of the California Assessor Association (CAA) President, the CAA Treasurer, the
8 coordinating Assessor, and 6 Assessors chosen by the member Assessors of the joint powers
9 authority; and; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Assessor to enter into a
11 Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement with other California counties to become a member of
12 the California County Assessors' Information Technology Authority to receive, manage, and
13 expend up to \$30,000,000 of State funds for technology improvements for County Assessor
14 Offices.
