

1 [Grant to develop and implement a local infrastructure to augment the current activities of the
2 San Francisco Childhood Lead Prevention Program.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **accept and expend a new grant in the amount of \$52,550 from the State Department of**
5 **Health Services (SDHS) Lead Hazard Reduction Compliance and Enforcement Program,**
6 **to enter into an agreement for the use of these funds, and to add one 0.1 position**
7 **funded through this grant; for the period of July 1, 2005, to June 30, 2006.**

9 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a Lead Hazard Reduction
10 Compliance and Enforcement Program grant from SDHS in the amount of \$52,550 to develop
11 and implement a local infrastructure to augment the current activities of the San Francisco
12 Childhood Lead Prevention Program; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SDHS requires the City to
14 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
15 Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of
16 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

17 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant
18 funds may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
19 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
20 of grant funding; and,

21 WHEREAS, One 0.1 position will be added through this grant; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$1,738; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the
25 amount of \$52,550 from SDHS; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
 2 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San
 3 Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
 5 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
 7 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
 8 agreement expires.
