Subject: Mayor's Veto - File No. 231079

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Today, March 14, 2024, Mayor London N. Breed communicated her veto of the following matter:

**File No. 231079 - Planning Code - Density Controls in Three Historic Districts**

Ordinance amending the Planning Code to modify density limits in the Northeast Waterfront Historic District, the Jackson Square Historic District, and the Jackson Square Historic District Extension, except for projects in those areas using the Commercial to Residential Adaptive Reuse Program; affirming the Planning Commission's determination under the California Environmental Quality Act; making public necessity, convenience, and welfare findings under Planning Code, Section 302; and making findings of consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of Planning Code, Section 101.1.

Pursuant to Charter, Section 2.106, the Board of Supervisors may override said veto if, within 30 days after such veto, not less than two-thirds of the Board of Supervisors shall vote in favor of such measure.

The last regular meeting you may consider a veto override is April 2, 2024; although, it could be calendared earlier if a member requests the matter be agendized earlier.

Please submit your request to calendar the override vote, in writing, no later than end of day, Wednesday, March 27, 2024. Otherwise, in 30 days the veto stands.

I will communicate the Mayor's veto letter at the March 19, 2024, Board Meeting.
