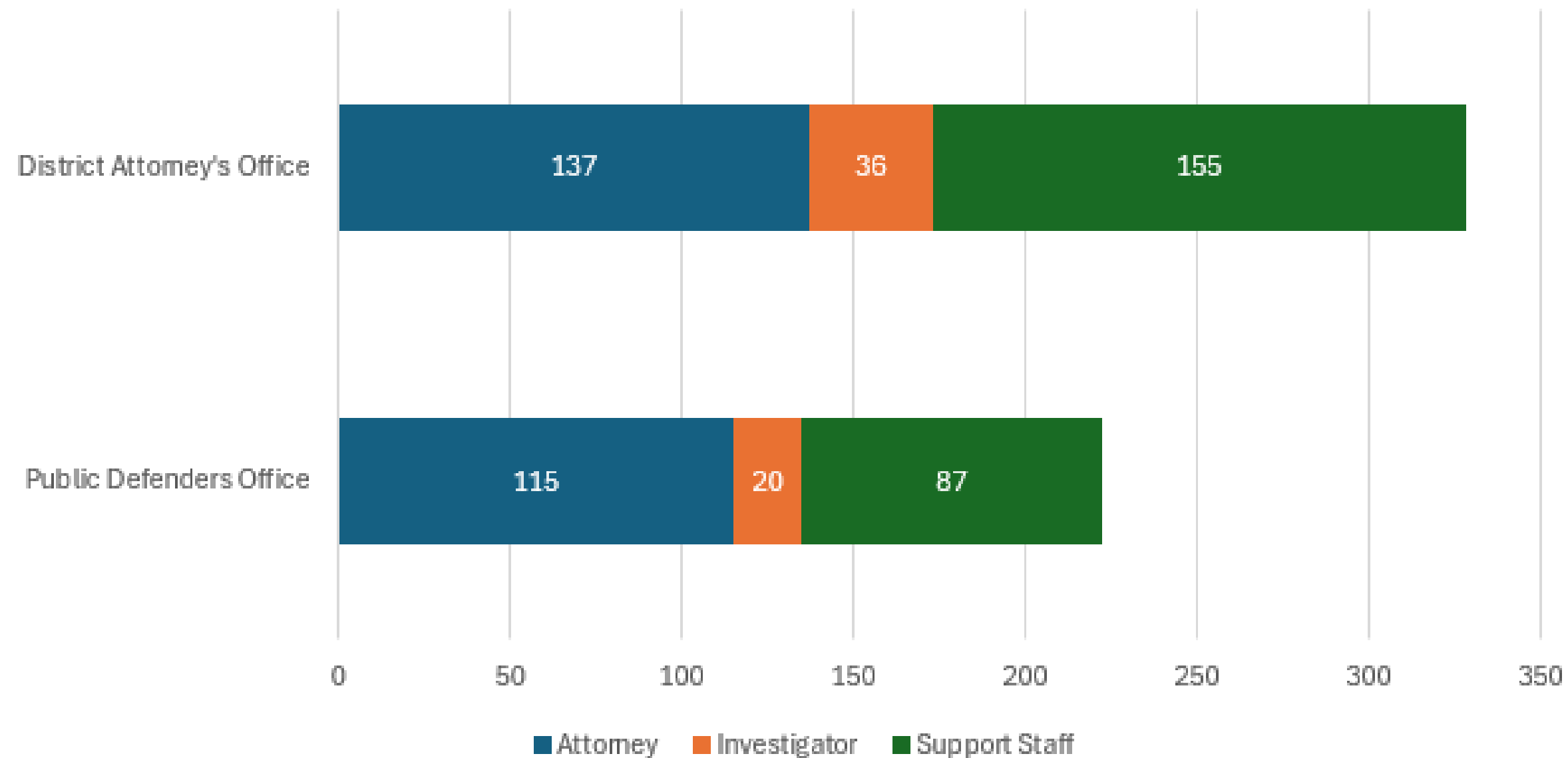

# Our Budget

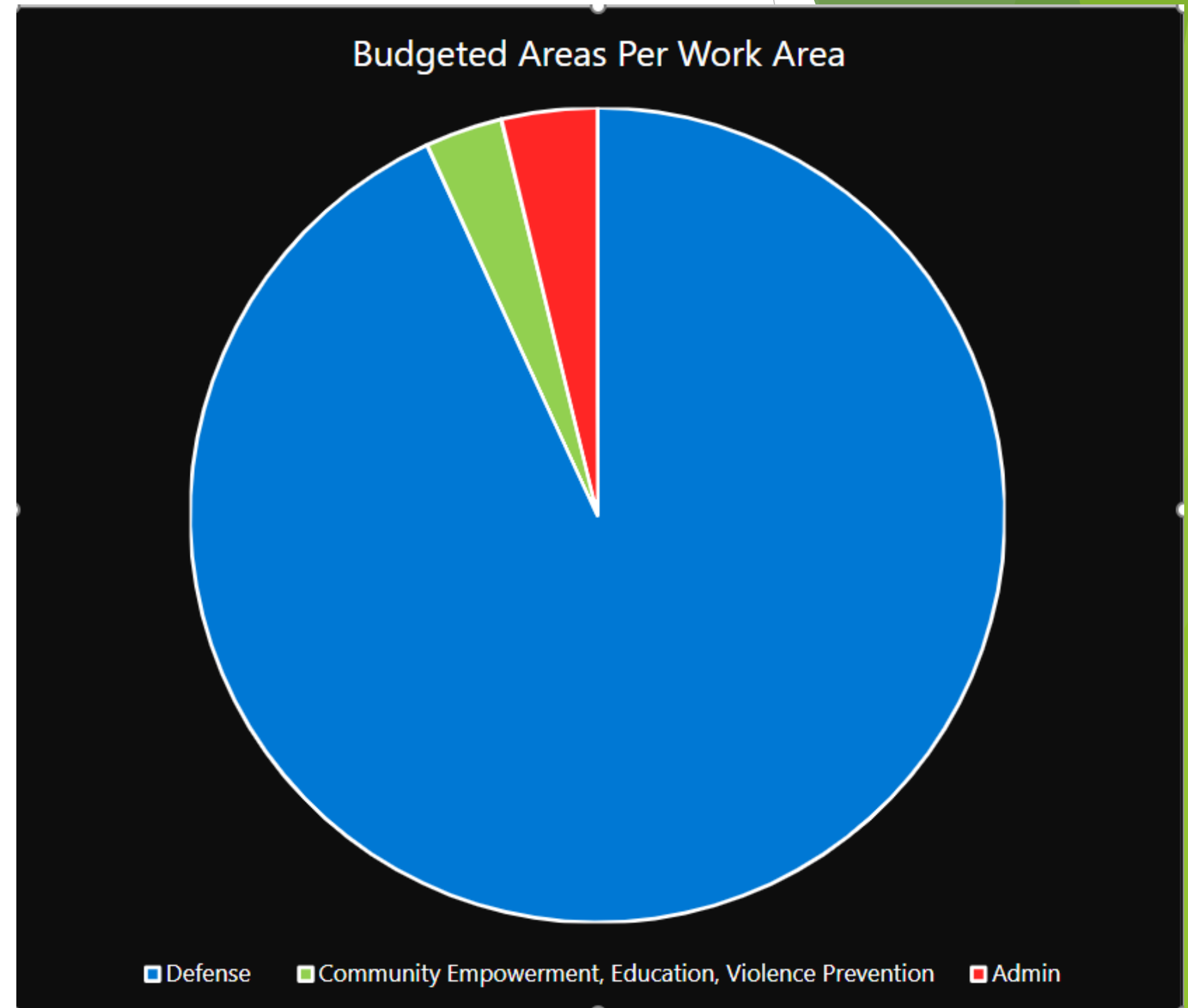


# Our Core & Legally Mandated Services

**93%** of our people-power is devoted to ***holistically defending*** the accused in all stages of misdemeanor, felony, mental health, juvenile, immigration cases, and reentry.

**4%** funds administrative functions (HR, Payroll, Finance)

**3%** funds public education, community empowerment, and violence prevention

# Our Continued Dedication to Public Safety & Reentry Initiatives

## Homecoming Project Partnership

Partnering with Impact Justice to launch a proven reentry housing program in San Francisco, addressing housing crisis disproportionately affecting formerly incarcerated individuals, supporting successful community reintegration and reducing recidivism.

## State Legislative Victory

Secured passage of AB 321 (BID Act), strengthening judicial discretion to reduce felony wobbler charges to misdemeanors before trial. Advances equity in charging decisions and expands opportunities for case resolution alternatives.

## Freedom Project

Resentencing and parole of people incarcerated in state prison — 108 people released with 100% successful re-entry due to skilled social worker support.

## Clean Slate

San Francisco’s lead program for expungement of criminal records, removing barriers to jobs and housing. Also vacates criminal convictions for survivors of human trafficking.
