[Reversing the	Exemption	Determination	Issued for	2514-23rd	Avenue]
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Motion reversing the determination by the Planning Department that the 2514-23rd Avenue project is exempt from environmental review.

WHEREAS, On May 18, 2010, Building Permit No. 2010/05/05/1781 was issued on by the Department of Building Inspection for a project at 2514 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. The proposed project (the "Project") would involve structural work to the foundation, roof framing and the addition of roof dormers, window replacement, and interior work to the building, which is a single-family residence. The building permit included an exemption determination by the Planning Department, which determined that the Project was exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the CEQA Guidelines, and San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31. By letter to the Clerk of the Board, Nancy Wuerfel, on behalf of the Sunset Parkside Education and Action Committee (SPEAK), ("Appellant"), received by the Clerk's Office on August 9, 2010, appealed the exemption determination; and

WHEREAS, On September 21, 2010, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider the appeal of the exemption determination filed by Appellant, and following the public hearing reversed the exemption determination; and

WHEREAS, In reviewing the appeal of the exemption determination, this Board reviewed and considered the exemption determination, the appeal letters, the responses to concerns document that the Planning Department prepared, the other written records before the Board of Supervisors and all of the public testimony made in support of and opposed to the exemption determination appeal. Following the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board of Supervisors reversed the exemption determination for the Project based on the

1	written record before the Board of Supervisors as well as all of the testimony at the public
2	hearing in support of and opposed to the appeal. The written record and oral testimony in
3	support of and opposed to the appeal and deliberation of the oral and written testimony at the
4	public hearing before the Board of Supervisors by all parties and the public in support of and
5	opposed to the appeal of the exemption determination is in the Clerk of the Board of
6	Supervisors File No. 101085 and in the Planning Department files, which are available for
7	public review by appointment at the Planning Department offices at 1650 Mission Street, and
8	are incorporated in this motion as though set forth in its entirety; now therefore be it
9	MOVED, That this Board of Supervisors reverses the determination by the Planning
10	Commission that the Project is exempt from environmental review.
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
