Resolution welcoming Daw Aung San Suu Kyi to the City and County of San Francisco and Honoring Our Commitment to Ongoing Human Rights Struggle in Burma

WHEREAS, Burma has been ruled by a military dictatorship since a coup d'état ended democratic governance in 1962. After holding free elections in 1990, the government annulled those elections when it decisively lost; and

WHEREAS, Daw Aung San Suu Kyi, Burma's democratic leader, was placed under house arrest after the elections along with hundreds of others who where imprisoned; and

WHEREAS, Daw Aung San Suu Kyi is a 1991 Nobel Peace Prize Laureate and is a Global Icon of nonviolent struggle for democracy and freedom throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, Since 1996, the City and County of San Francisco has passed multiple resolutions in sport of Burma's democracy movement including declaring August 8th as Annual BURMA DAY, June 19th as Daw Aung San Suu Kyi Day and May 27th as Burma Democracy Day; and

WHEREAS, The international community has recognized the reform agendas and positive steps taken by Burma's new government led by President Thein Sein and U.S. has recently eased sanctions in supports the reforms in Burma; and

WHEREAS, The National League for Democracy (NLD) party led by Daw Aung San Suu Kyi won a landslide victory in the Burma's mid-term by-election held on April 1st 2012; and

WHEREAS, In her victory speech on April 2nd, 2012, Daw Aung San Suu Kyi mentioned the "beginning of a new era" after being elected to the parliament, and she is now working with all reformists to implement the reforms in Burma; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Congress is awarding Daw Aung San Suu Kyi a Congressional Gold Medal on September 19th 2012 in a ceremony at the U.S. Congress; and

WHEREAS, the Burmese Community and its supporters are working with the State department and Daw Aung San Suu Kyi's liaison to plan a public meeting in the San Francisco on September 29th 2012; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco is the birthplace of the United Nations; and

WHEREAS, It is our responsibility to speak out and aid the nonviolent struggle against injustice throughout the world; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco welcomes Daw Aung San Suu Kyi's visit to the city of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco sponsors the Burmese Community Meeting with Daw Aung San Suu Kyi on September 29th 2012 and provide support; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco formally urges the Burma's president Thein Sein's reform platform as well as urges the release of all the political prisoners in Burma.
