4 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to participate in the California**
5 **State Department of Healthcare Services' State Technical Assistance Marketplace**
6 **program on terms and conditions that include a Release of Claims by the City and**
7 **County of San Francisco.**

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9 WHEREAS, The State Department of Healthcare Services ("DHCS") has launched a
10 five-year \$1.85 billion initiative called Providing Access and Transforming Health ("PATH") to
11 help partners, including the Department of Public Health ("DPH"), participate successfully in
12 the Medi-Cal delivery system, while DHCS implements PATH program components called
13 "Enhanced Care Management" and "Community Supports;" and

14 WHEREAS, Enhanced Care Management and Community Supports are revenue
15 generating programs that provide care management to Managed Care Plan members and
16 cost-effective alternatives to traditional medical settings; and

17 WHEREAS, As part of PATH, DHCS offers a virtual Technical Assistance Marketplace
18 ("TA Marketplace") providing no-cost technical support for entities attempting to implement
19 and expand Enhanced Care Management and Community Supports; and

20 WHEREAS, DPH wishes to participate in the TA Marketplace offerings; and

21 WHEREAS, DHCS requires that all TA Marketplace participants acknowledge TA
22 Marketplace terms and conditions ("Acknowledgement"), including a requirement that
23 participants release and hold harmless DHCS, its TA Marketplace administrator, and their
24 respective officers, agents, employees, representatives, and/or designees from and against
25 any and all liability, actions, claims, demands, or suits, and all related costs, attorney fees,

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and expenses arising out of, or relating to the PATH TA Marketplace Program (“Release of Claims”); and

WHEREAS, A copy of the TA Marketplace participant Acknowledgement, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 240254, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby finds DPH’s participation in the TA Marketplace to be in the City’s best interests and on that basis authorizes the Director of Health to agree to the TA Marketplace Acknowledgement terms and conditions, including the Release of Claims.
