

1 [Juvenile Probation Department—Daily Fee at Juvenile Hall and Log Cabin Ranch]

3 **Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Sections**
4 **10.39-5 and 10.39-6 to establish daily fees at Juvenile Hall and Log Cabin Ranch and to**
5 **designate a Financial Evaluation Officer to evaluate ability of persons to pay such fees,**
6 **to become operative on its effective date or on July 1, 2009, whichever is later, and**
7 **making environmental findings.**

11 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

12 Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
13 this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
14 Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of
15 the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by
16 reference.

18 Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
19 Section 10.39-5, to read as follows:

20 Sec.10-39.5. DAILY FEE AT JUVENILE HALL AND LOG CABIN RANCH.

21 The Juvenile Probation Department is hereby authorized to collect a daily fee for the care,
22 support and maintenance of any minor detained or committed to Juvenile Hall and for any minor
23 committed to Log Cabin Ranch, as authorized by California Welfare and Institutions Code sections 903
24 and 904. The daily fee for a minor detained or committed to Juvenile Hall shall be \$14.30. The daily
25 fee for a minor committed to Log Cabin Ranch shall be \$25.80. Pursuant to California Welfare and

1 Institutions Code section 903.45, the total amount charged may be reduced based on an assessment
2 that the person or persons obligated to pay the fee on behalf of the minor are unable to pay the full
3 amount.

5 Section 3. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
6 Section 10.39-6, to read as follows:

7 Sec. 10.39-6. ASSESSMENT OF ABILITY TO PAY MINOR'S FEES

8 The Chief Juvenile Probation Officer, or his or her designee, is designated as the Financial
9 Evaluation Officer who, pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions Code section 903.45, makes
10 the financial evaluation of parental liability for reimbursement for daily fees charged for the care,
11 support and maintenance of any minor detained or committed to Juvenile Hall and for any minor
12 committed to Log Cabin Ranch, as authorized by California Welfare and Institutions Code sections 903
13 and 904. In evaluating a person's ability to pay, the Financial Evaluation Officer shall take into
14 account the factors enumerated in section 903.45. If he or she determines that a person so responsible
15 has the ability to pay all or part of the costs, the Financial Evaluation Officer may petition the court for
16 an order requiring the person to pay that sum to the City and County of San Francisco.
