

1 [Appointments, Office of Early Care and Education Citizens' Advisory Committee - Yohana
2 Quiroz and Sandee Blechman]

3 **Motion appointing Yohana Quiroz (residency requirement waived) and Sandee**
4 **Blechman, terms ending May 1, 2020, to the Office of Early Care and Education**
5 **Citizens' Advisory Committee.**

7 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Office of Early
9 Care and Education Citizens' Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of
10 Administrative Code, Section 5.120, et seq., for the terms specified:

11 Yohana Quiroz (residency requirement waived), seat 7, succeeding Kathie Herrera-
12 Autumn, term expired, must be a provider of early care and education at a community-based
13 childcare center in San Francisco, but this member cannot be a San Francisco Unified School
14 District provider, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending May 1, 2020.

15 Sandee Blechman, seat 9, succeeding themselves, term expired, must be a
16 representative of the Childcare Planning and Advisory Council and nominated to the Board of
17 Supervisors, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending May 1, 2020.

18 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 19 1. The membership of the Office of Early Care and Education Citizens' Advisory
20 Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and
21 County of San Francisco.
- 22 2. Applicant Yohana Quiroz, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person
23 with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Office of Early Care
24 and Education Citizens' Advisory Committee.

- 1 3. The Office of Early Care and Education Citizens' Advisory Committee has
2 attempted to fill the positions, for which Yohana Quiroz was nominated, with
3 individuals who are City residents and who have the specific experience, skills,
4 and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules
5 Committee has certified that Yohana Quiroz is qualified to serve on the Office of
6 Early Care and Education Citizens' Advisory Committee.
- 7 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is
8 no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who
9 has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these
10 applicants, and who are willing to serve on the Office of Early Care and
11 Education Citizens' Advisory Committee at this time; and, be it

12 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
13 for Yohana Quiroz, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can
14 be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to
15 boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of
16 Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
