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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **enter retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$72,500 with The Regents of the**
5 **University of California San Francisco (UCSF), the primary contractor, for the HIV**
6 **Prevention Planning Collaborative Allocation Tool project under a one year award from**
7 **the DHHS Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC); for the period of**
8 **September 30, 2001 to September 29, 2002.**

10 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant from CDC for the conduct of a one year
11 study titled "Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Applied Research" ; and,

12 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of CDC, UCSF, and SFDPH to
13 participate in this project; and,

14 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$72,500 from
15 the grant award; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH to enter into a
17 subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
18 Supervisors in File No. 020182, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as
19 if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$7,768;
21 now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
23 agreement in the amount of \$72,500 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for a project entitled
24 HIV Prevention Planning Collaborative Allocation Tool; and, be it
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

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FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it


