2 GARAGES]

3 AMENDING SECTION 2A.180 OF THE SAN FRANCISCO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO
4 GRANT AUTHORITY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO SELL GIFT
5 CERTIFICATES FOR PAYMENT FOR PARKING AT CITY GARAGES.

6 Note: Additions are underlined; deletions are in ((double parentheses)).

7 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

8 Section 1. Article X of the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by
9 amending Section 2A.180, to read as follows:

10 **SEC. 2A.180. DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC—FUNCTIONS AND**
11 **DUTIES.** (a) The Department of Parking and Traffic shall be responsible for the day to day
12 operation of the affairs placed under its jurisdiction, including but not limited to the following
13 functions and operations:

- 14 (1) Traffic signal maintenance;
- 15 (2) Sign shops;
- 16 (3) Authorization and administration of colored curb marking;
- 17 (4) Enforcement of parking and traffic regulations;
- 18 (5) Establishment, enforcement and administration of residential parking permit
19 zones;
- 20 (6) Meter planning, collection, coin counting and maintenance;
- 21 (7) Off-street parking except at airports;
- 22 (8) Parking ticket enforcement, parking control officers, parking offense towing,
23 scofflaw programs, the sale of gift certificates for the payment for parking at City garages, the
24 maintenance of information on the issuance and disposition of parking citations and
25 maintenance of liaison with the municipal court;

1 (9) Administration of the Interdepartmental Committee on Traffic and
2 Transportation.

3 (b) The Department of Parking and Traffic shall have powers and duties relating to
4 street traffic, subject to the laws relating thereto, as follows:

5 (1) To cooperate with and assist the Police Department in the promotion of traffic
6 safety education;

7 (2) To receive, study and give prompt attention to complaints relating to street
8 design or traffic devices or the absence thereof;

9 (3) To collect, compile, analyze and interpret traffic and parking data and to analyze
10 and interpret traffic accident information;

11 (4) To engage in traffic research and traffic planning; and

12 (5) To cooperate for the best performance of these functions with any department
13 and agency of the City and County and State as may be necessary.

14 (c) The department shall submit to the Traffic Bureau of the Police Department, for
15 its review and recommendation, all proposed plans relating to street traffic-control devices;
16 provided, however, that the Bureau may waive submission and review of plans and particular
17 devices designated by it. Failure of the said Traffic Bureau to submit to the Department its
18 recommendation on any proposed plan within 15 days after receipt shall be considered an
19 automatic approval of said Traffic Bureau. The Department shall not, with respect to any
20 traffic- control devices, implement such plan until the recommendation of the Traffic Bureau
21 has been reviewed or until the 15-day period has elapsed.






