

1 [Memorandum of Understanding Agreement - United States Capitol Police - Supplemental
2 Law Enforcement Services]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Police Department to enter into a**
4 **Memorandum of Understanding Agreement with the United States Capitol Police to**
5 **provide supplemental law enforcement services for the period beginning on January**
6 **1, 2026, and ending on December 31, 2026.**

8 WHEREAS, The United States Capitol Police (USCP) is a federal law enforcement
9 agency in the United States with the responsibility for protecting members of the United
10 States Congress within the District of Columbia and throughout the United States and its
11 territories; and

12 WHEREAS, The USCP has approached the San Francisco Police Department
13 (SFPD) to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding Agreement (the Agreement) seeking
14 supplemental law enforcement services that fall outside the scope of Administrative Code
15 10B and California Government Code, Section 53069.8; and

16 WHEREAS, The SFPD anticipates the Agreement with USCP to generate revenues
17 of more than \$1,000,000; and

18 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Charter, Section 9.118 requires the Board of
19 Supervisors to approve agreements having anticipated revenue to the City of more than
20 \$1,000,000; and

21 WHEREAS, The contracting for these law enforcement services shall not reduce the
22 normal and regular ongoing service that SFPD otherwise would provide; now, therefore, be
23 it

24 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief of Police, or his
25 designee, to execute, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the Agreement

1 with USCP to authorize SFPD to provide supplemental law enforcement services for the
2 period beginning on January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFPD may enter into any modification of the
4 Agreement that the Chief of Police determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in
5 the best interests of the City, are necessary and advisable to effectuate the purpose of the
6 Agreement or this Resolution, do not materially increase the obligations of the City, and are
7 in compliance with all applicable laws, including the City's Charter; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFPD has received the endorsement of Mayor
9 Daniel Lurie, who hereby sponsors this Resolution in support of the Agreement and its
10 implementation; and, be it

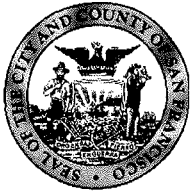
11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within (30) days of the Agreement being fully executed
