17	since their inception and deems them vital to the continued well-being of its residents; and
18	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will encourage initiatives that
19	strengthen emergency planning, first responder preparedness, and community safety,
20	resilience, and recovery; and
21	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, as fiscal agent for the Department
22	of Emergency Management, is committed to ensuring all grant funds are utilized in a
23	compliant, appropriate, and transparent manner (including planning, organization, equipment,
24	training, and exercises) that respects the civil rights and civil liberties of all San Francisco Bay

Area residents; and

1	WHEREAS, The State of California requires that applicant's agents be named in the
2	Resolution, now, therefore, be it
3	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
4	authorizes the Executive Director of the Department of Emergency Management; or in his or
5	her absence, the Chief Financial Officer, the Deputy Director, or the Assistant Deputy Director
6	of the Department of Emergency Management, to execute for and on behalf of the City and
7	County of San Francisco, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California,
8	any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining State and Federal financial assistance
9	provided by the Federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State
10	of California, as well as provided directly by the State of California, including the FY 2021
11	EMPG-ARPA for the funding amount of \$66,761.
