3 **Resolution declaring the results of the November 8, 2022, Consolidated General**

6 WHEREAS, A Consolidated General Election was conducted in the City and
7 County of San Francisco on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, which placed before the
8 electorate candidates for Assessor-Recorder, District Attorney, Public Defender, the
9 San Francisco Board of Supervisors, the Board of Trustees for the Community
10 College District, the Governing Board of the San Francisco Unified School District,
11 BART District Board of Directors and local ballot measures; and

12 WHEREAS, John Arntz, the Director of Elections for the City and County of San
13 Francisco, has certified the results of the Consolidated General Election, a copy of
14 which is contained in Board File No. 221252, and which is incorporated herein by
15 reference; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That under California Elections Code, Sections 9269 and 15400,
17 this Board of Supervisors affirms the Director of Elections' certified results for the City

2. Ordinances

The following Ordinance required and received an affirmative vote of two-thirds (66.67%) of the votes cast thereon and was therefore passed by the voters:

PROPOSITION L: Sales Tax for Transportation Projects

The following Ordinances required and received an affirmative vote of a majority (50%, plus 1) of the votes cast thereon and were therefore passed by the voters:

PROPOSITION J: Recreational Use of JFK Drive in Golden Gate Park

PROPOSITION M: Tax on Keeping Residential Units Vacant

PROPOSITION N: Golden Gate Park Underground Parking Facility;
Golden Gate Park Concourse Authority

All other local ballot measures failed to meet the legally required vote thresholds for adoption.
