WHEREAS, The Civil Service Commission has performed its charge to oversee, regulate, and serve as final arbiter of the City and County of San Francisco civil service merit system; and

WHEREAS, The first competitive examination was held on January 8, 1900; and

WHEREAS, The Civil Service Commission has established, ensured and maintained an equitable and credible merit system for public service for the citizens of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, In the 100 years of its operation, the Commission has responded to the changing needs of personnel management through an effective, fair and modern system that SUPERVISOR, KAUFMAN, NEWSOM, TENG, BECERRIL, BIERMAN, KATZ

recognizes and builds on the diversity, skills and dedication of public employees, and consistently provides the best qualified candidates for public service in a timely and cost effective manner; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco takes this opportunity to commend the San Francisco Civil Service Commission on its 100th anniversary celebration on January 5, 2000, and recognizes its outstanding contribution and service to the citizens of the City and County of San Francisco.
