Ordinance amending the Health Code and Police Code to extend the sunset date for possession, growing, medical cannabis dispensaries from December 31, 2022 to December 31, 2024, and to allow the extension of Temporary Cannabis Business Permits for additional 120-day terms through December 31, 2024, rather than December 31, 2022, allowing the Planning Department's administration under the California Environmental Quality Act, and making findings of consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of Planning Code, Section 162-1, ADDENDUM to Public Safety and Neighborhood Services Committee.
