

1 [Approval of Reimbursable Professional Services Agreement between the Airport and  
2 Siemens Dematic Group for the project management and construction management services  
3 for domestic terminal explosive detection baggage inspection systems in the estimated  
amount of \$2,160,000.]

4 **Resolution approving the Reimbursable Professional Services Agreement with**  
5 **Siemens Dematic Group for the project management and construction management**  
6 **services in the estimated amount of \$2,160,000.**

8 WHEREAS, In response to the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks, Congress passed  
9 the Federal Aviation and Transportation Security Act, which requires all checked baggage to  
10 be screened for explosives; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has contracted with the  
12 Boeing Company to implement explosive detection baggage inspection systems at 429  
13 airports throughout the United States; and,

14 WHEREAS, Boeing has partnered with Siemens Dematic Group for this nationwide  
15 project; and,

16 WHEREAS, It has been determined that the most efficient means of managing this  
17 project to satisfy both TSA's and the Airport's requirements at the domestic terminals is for  
18 the Airport to provide project management and construction management services for the  
19 project pursuant to a reimbursable agreement with Siemens Dematic Group; and,

20 WHEREAS, The Airport's costs will be fully reimbursed by Siemens Dematic Group;  
21 and,

22 WHEREAS, On November 19, 2002, the Airport Commission authorized the Airport to  
23 enter into a Reimbursable Professional Services Agreement with Siemens Dematic Group for

1 the project management and construction management services in the estimated amount of  
2 \$2,160,000. A copy is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ,  
3 which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

4 WHEREAS, In accordance with City Charter Section 9.118(a), whereby any contract  
5 which when entered into has anticipated revenue of one million dollars or more, are subject to  
6 the approval by the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Reimbursable  
8 Professional Services Agreement between the Airport and Siemens Dematic Group for the  
9 project management and construction management services for domestic terminal explosive  
10 detection baggage inspection systems in the estimated amount of \$2,160,000.
