[Stop Sign Designation – Francisco and Mason Streets]

Resolution urging the installation of 4-way Stop signs at the intersection of Francisco and Mason Streets

WHEREAS, Currently the intersection of Francisco and Mason Streets is regulated by 2-way stop signs; and

WHEREAS, 5,900 vehicles cross this intersection per day on Mason Street, 2,500 vehicles cross per day on Francisco Street, and 3,000 pedestrians cross per day on Francisco Street; and

WHEREAS. This high level of automobile and pedestrian volume, combined with the intersection's two-way stop signs, have made this intersection dangerous for both pedestrians and vehicles; and

WHEREAS, This intersection is one block from Francisco Middle School and is a hazardous intersection for students; and

WHEREAS, Residents and merchants in the vicinity of Francisco and Mason Streets have requested that this intersection be made a 4-way stop; and,

WHEREAS, In 2002, the Department of Parking and Traffic (DPT) conducted an investigation regarding the feasibility of installing additional stop signs at this intersection and stated that such installation would not affect MUNI operations; and,

WHEREAS, It is important for the City to ensure traffic safety at this vibrant neighborhood intersection; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code, strongly urges the

Department of Parking and Traffic to install 4-way Stop signs at the intersection of Francisco and Mason Streets.
