2	personal vehicles to be used in car-sharing programs]

4	Resolution supporting Assembly Bill 1871 (Jones) to amend state car insurance laws
5	to allow personal vehicles to be used in car-sharing programs.
6	
7	WHEREAS, Car-sharing is a membership service that provides 24-hour access and
8	use of automobiles for short periods of time, often by the hour; and
9	WHEREAS, Because occasional use of a shared vehicle costs significantly less than
10	car ownership, carsharing makes vehicles more accessible to low-income households; and,
11	WHEREAS, Car-sharing can also help reduce traffic congestion and pollution, and
12	ultimately the need to manufacture as many new automobiles; and,
13	WHEREAS, Vehicles in car-sharing programs tend to be small, fuel-efficient and carry
14	several people, reducing the use of gasoline a well as the need for parking spaces; and,
15	WHEREAS, Car-sharing programs have been successful in densely populated areas
16	such as city centers and university campuses; and,
17	WHEREAS, Car-sharing organizations would like to expand their pools of vehicles by
18	using cars owned by individuals during times when they are not using them; and,
19	WHEREAS, Because private vehicle owners would receive some money for the use of
20	their car, this could constitute commercial use, and thereby invalidate the private individual's
21	insurance coverage; and,
22	WHEREAS, The use of privately owned vehicles also raises liability issues when being
23	used by someone other than the vehicle's owner; and,

1	WHEREAS, Existing law does not consider the use of an insured motor vehicle to
.2	provide volunteer services for nonprofit charitable organizations or governmental agencies to
3	be commercial use; and,
4	WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1871 would extend this protection to personal vehicle
5	sharing; and,
6	WHEREAS, The bill also protects against liability of the car owner's insurance
7	company and places responsibility on the personal vehicle sharing program and its insurer;
8	and,
9	WHEREAS, A copy of AB 1871 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in
10	File No. , which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein;
11	and, now, therefore, be it
12	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors supports Assembly Bill
13	1871 (Jones) and urges its passage and enactment by the Governor; and, be it
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Mayor with
15	a request that he transmit copies to the members of the state legislative delegation
16	representing San Francisco.
