Shoplifting Immediate Response Process

01

Patrol

Units respond to calls for service received.

03

Investigative Info

Officers collect detailed investigative information on the front end (suspect descriptions, loss inventories, video evidence, etc.)



02

Police Reports

Police reports are forwarded to SFPD investigative units for follow up

04

Outreach

District outreaches to communities impacted and crime alerts are issues

Shoplifting Response Strategies


PREVENTION & INTERVENTION

- Foot Beats Commercial Corridors
- Consistent Passing Calls
- Data-Driven Policing Focusing on known areas of shoplifting
- Marked patrol vehicles parked outside storefronts
- Some locations have opted to hire off-duty SFPD officers for security (10B)
- Investigation's strategies

OUTREACH

- District Captain meets with Merchants Associations and Retail Store Managements to discuss security concerns & discuss collaborations
- Safety walks in commercial corridors with station/SFPD personnel

Shoplifting Incidents & Arrests Three Year Comparison





2020 Citywide Shoplifting Incidents By Month




