WHEREAS, Neighbors along 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue near Ortega Street have complained about the excessive speeding along 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue and noted that speeding is a very common occurrence; and,

WHEREAS, For three blocks along 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, including its intersection with Ortega Street, there are no stop signs to slow down traffic; and,

WHEREAS, On  $16^{\rm th}$  Avenue, a similar residential corridor one street over from  $15^{\rm th}$  Avenue, stop signs have been effective in reducing speeding; and,

WHEREAS, Over the years, neighbors have made repeated requests for the installation of stop signs and increased enforcement measures to ensure pedestrian safety and prevent excessive speeding on 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, Despite residents' efforts, the problem of speeding vehicles on  $15^{\rm th}$  Avenue has persisted; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to install stop signs at the intersection of  $15^{\rm th}$  Avenue and Ortega

Street to improve the traffic safety in the area and to install the stop signs within 30 days after the Mayor signs the legislation.
