

1 [Grant to support the Shape Up BVHP program.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**  
4 **and expend retroactively a two-year grant from Kaiser Permanente in the amount of**  
5 **\$150,000 for the project entitled “Shape Up BVHP,” for the period of October 1, 2007**  
6 **through September 30, 2009, which includes a subcontract with the SF Study Center**  
7 **for \$130,610 for the same time period.**

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9 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from Kaiser Permanente in the amount of  
10 \$150,000, for the period of October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2009; and,

11 WHEREAS, The grant supports chronic disease prevention utilizing community and  
12 school-based gardens in Bayview Hunters Point (BVHP) and builds on a previous grant that  
13 funded a planning process with parents and teachers at Bret Harte Elementary school; and,

14 WHEREAS, The grant includes a subcontract with the SF Study Center for \$130,610 to  
15 act as fiscal agent; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the University of California  
17 requires the City to enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with  
18 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 071676; which is hereby declared to be a  
19 part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses the  
21 department for an existing position, Health Educator (Job Class #2819) at .10 FTE; and,

22 WHEREAS, The indirect costs are not included in the budget in order to maximize use  
23 of grant funds on direct services; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant  
25 in the amount of \$150,000 from California Kaiser Permanente; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
2 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,  
3 be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
5 indirect costs; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
7 funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when  
8 the agreement expires; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
10 agreement on behalf of the City.
