Resolution enacting and rescinding traffic regulations on various streets.

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

MULTIPLE RIGHT TURN LANES - RESCIND
RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT - ESTABLISH

Howard Street, westbound, at 9th Street

BICYCLE LANES - ESTABLISH

Howard Street, between 9th Street and 200 feet easterly

SAN FRANCISCO DEPARTMENT OF CITY PLANNING
CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

CLASS 1 (C)15 Rechannelization or change of traffic direction, where no more than a negligible increase in use of the street will result.


