WHEREAS, The First Offender Prostitution Program is a unique collaboration between law enforcement, public health and private agencies which takes an educational approach rather than a punitive one to San Francisco's prostitution problem; and

WHEREAS, Since its induction in 1995, the First Offender Prostitution Program has achieved positive results, serving over 1,850 girls, 6,000 women and over 1,900 male customers; and

WHEREAS, Of the over 1,900 men who have completed the educational program addressing the legal, health and other risks of soliciting prostitution, only 14 have re-offended; and

WHEREAS, The First Offender Prostitution Program has made significant advancements in helping women and girls to permanently exit the criminal justice system and to rebuild their lives free of sexual exploitation and abuse; and

WHEREAS, In recognition of its efforts and its successes, the First Offender Prostitution Program has been awarded an Innovations in Government Award by the

SUPERVISOR KAUFMAN, NEWSOM, MEDINA, KATZ BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Ford Foundation and the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University; and

WHEREAS, Only 10 programs out of 1480 applicants received Innovations in Government Awards this year and, out of those 10, the First Offenders Prostitution Program was rated number one; and

WHEREAS, The First Offenders Prostitution Program is the first program of any kind in San Francisco to receive an Innovations in Government Award; and

WHEREAS, Norma Hotaling and Standing Against Global Exploitation (SAGE) played a critical role in creating and implementing the First Offenders Prostitution Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby commends Norma Hotaling and Standing Against Global Exploitation (SAGE) for the Innovations in Government Award won by the First Offenders Prostitution Program.
