16 IHSS Consortium of San Francisco at its meeting of May 6, 2009; now, therefore, be it

17 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves award of this contract to  
18 the IHSS Consortium of San Francisco for the period of July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2013, in the  
19 amount of \$83,444,020.
