SEC. 3.106. EMERGENCY PLANNING AND RESPONSE.

The mayor shall designate an officer or employee within the City service to manage the City's emergency planning and response. This individual must have at the time of designation a total of at least ten years of employment or professional service in any of the following disciplines: firefighting, law enforcement, public health, or military service, or in the fields of disaster management or emergency preparedness and relief at the local, state, or federal level. At least five years of that experience or professional service shall be at a management level.
