3 **Resolution declaring May 2006 Foster Care Month and urges all community members**  
4 **to volunteer their talents and energies to honor children and youth in foster care and**  
5 **foster care alumni during this month and throughout the year.**

7 WHEREAS, The family is the foundation of strong and healthy communities; and

8 WHEREAS, Twenty percent of the nation's foster care youth live in California; and,

9 WHEREAS, On October 1, 2005, there were 1,992 children and youth in foster care in  
10 San Francisco; and,

11 WHEREAS, Approximately 185 youth will "age out" or emancipate in San Francisco  
12 this year; and

13 WHEREAS, Nationally eighty-three percent of foster children are held back by the third  
14 grade; and

15 WHEREAS, Nationally nearly fifty percent of foster children suffer from chronic health  
16 conditions; and

17 WHEREAS, A history of foster care correlates with becoming homeless at an earlier  
18 age and remaining homeless for a long period of time; and

19 WHEREAS, More than half of these San Francisco children and youth are cared for by  
20 family members through kin foster placements; and

21 WHEREAS, More dedicated foster parents are needed to provide family care for  
22 children who cannot live with their parents; and

23 WHEREAS, It is the responsibility of the entire community to make sure that each  
24 youth who leaves the foster care system in California has a permanent lifelong connection  
25 with a caring adult; and

1           WHEREAS, San Francisco is committed to youth engagement, empowerment, and  
2 leadership; and

3           WHEREAS, Current and former foster youth have the unique capacity to educate  
4 policy makers and the general public about the distinct needs of foster care youth; and

5           WHEREAS, There are numerous individuals and public, private and nonprofit  
6 organizations that work to empower and support foster youth; now, therefore, be it

7           RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisor declares May 2006 Foster  
8 Care Month and urges all community members to volunteer their talents and energies to  
9 honor children and youth in foster care and foster care alumni during this month and  
10 throughout the year.
