3 **Resolution Extending The Prescribed Time Within Which The Planning Commission**
4 **May Render Its Decision On A Proposed Ordinance To Amend The Planning Code To**
5 **Adopt An Inclusionary Affordable Housing Program.**

7 WHEREAS, On July 10, 2000, the Board of Supervisors initiated the process to amend
8 the Planning Code, when the Honorable Mark Leno introduced and the Honorable Gavin
9 Newsom, Sue Bierman and Leslie Katz co-sponsored a proposed ordinance to adopt an
10 inclusionary affordable housing program, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board
11 of Supervisors in File No. 001262; and,

12 WHEREAS, On July 13, 2000 the proposed ordinance was referred to the Planning
13 Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has requested additional time to review the
15 proposed ordinance; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by
17 resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its
18 decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code initiated by the Board of
19 Supervisors; and,

20 WHEREAS, On October 2, 2000 the Board granted a 90-day extension to the Planning
21 Commission to review the proposed ordinance; and,

22 WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning
23 Commission an additional 90 days to review the proposed ordinance and render its decision;


