

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - San Francisco Parks Alliance - Scholarship Programs -
2 \$150,000]

4 **Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a**
5 **grant of \$150,000 from the San Francisco Parks Alliance to benefit the Department’s**
6 **scholarship program for the project term of November 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019.**

8 WHEREAS, The City, through the Recreation and Park Department (“RPD”), operates
9 the Edwin M. Lee scholarship program which helps to subsidize the cost of attending RPD
10 recreation programs for eligible residents, ensuring that all San Franciscans can access RPD
11 programs regardless of ability or inability to pay; and

12 WHEREAS, Since 1971 the San Francisco Parks Alliance (“SFPA”), a non-profit
13 organization, has been a partner of, fiscal sponsor to and philanthropic benefactor of the
14 Recreation and Park Department, supporting San Francisco’s parks, open spaces and
15 recreation programs; and

16 WHEREAS, RPD, in partnership with SFPA as fiscal sponsor, holds an annual
17 fundraiser event each February known as Crab Fest, which provides important support each
18 year for the scholarship program; and

19 WHEREAS, SFPA wishes to grant RPD a cash grant of \$150,000, generated from this
20 year’s Crab Fest event, to benefit the scholarship program; and

21 WHEREAS, On June 21, 2018, the Recreation and Park Commission, by Resolution
22 No. 1806-004, recommended that the Board of Supervisors authorize RPD to accept and
23 expend a cash grant in the amount of \$150,000 from SFPA to support the Edwin M. Lee
24 scholarship program; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Grant and authorizes the
2 Recreation and Park Department General Manager to accept and expend the Grant, and to
3 perform all acts required of the City there under; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
5 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and Park
7 General Manager to enter into any modifications to the Grant that the Recreation and Park
8 General Manager determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interests
9 of the City and do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are
10 necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Grant or this Resolution, and are in
11 compliance with all applicable laws, including the City's Charter.
