1	[Resolution to Accept and Expend Funds from a Federal Highway Administration Cooperative Agreement for a Pedestrian Safety Study]

3	Resolution authorizing the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic		
4	(DPT) to retroactively apply for, accept, and expend funds from a cooperative		
5	agreement with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for a pedestrian safety		
6	engineering study (with federal funding of \$155,735) and to execute any necessary		
7	documents.		
8	WHEREAS, The improvement of pedestrian safety is a critical priority in San		
10	Francisco; and		
11	WHEREAS, there are a number of innovative technologies and approaches to improve		
12	pedestrian safety, but these need to be systematically assessed and targeted to the mos effective locations through a pedestrian master plan, and		
13			
14	WHEREAS, The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has offered to sign a		
15	cooperative agreement with DPT and the UC Berkeley Traffic Safety Center to fund most of the costs of a pedestrian safety engineering study, which could provide a core component of a		
16 17			
18	pedestrian master plan; and		
19	WHEREAS, The value of federal funding for Phase I (development of the pedestrian		
20	safety plan) is approximately \$156,000, and for the optional Phase II (plan implementation)		
21	about \$560,000 for construction costs for physical improvements and education/outreact		
22	efforts; and		
23	WHEREAS, the Parking and Traffic Commission on October 2, 2001 approved		
24 25	Resolution No. 164-01-PTC, urging the Board of Supervisors to authorize the Executive		

1	Director to retroactively apply for, accept, and expend funds from this FHWA cooperative		
2	agreement; and		
3 4 5	WHEREAS, the cooperative agreement budget includes provisions for indirect costs of \$617 for DPT and subcontract costs of \$127,095 for UC Berkeley; now, therefore, be it		
6	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco		
7	do hereby authorize the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to		
8	retroactively apply for, accept and expend funds from an FHWA cooperative agreement to		
9	improve pedestrian safety and to execute any necessary documents.
