| 5 | WHEREAS, On November 13, 2004, the Environmental Review Officer of the Planning |
| 6 | Department issued a preliminary mitigated negative declaration for 787 (aka 785) Brannan |
| 7 | Street in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the CEQA |
| 8 | Guidelines and San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31; and |
| 9 | WHEREAS, On February 3, 2005, following a noticed public hearing, the Planning |
| 10 | Commission by motion adopted a Final Mitigated Negative Declaration for 787 (aka 785) |
| 11 | Brannan Street ("negative declaration") in accordance with Administrative Code Section |
| 12 | 31.11(h). A copy of said document is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File |
| 13 | No. 050365 and is incorporated by reference herein; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, On February 23, 2005, the Clerk of the Board received an appeal of the |
| 15 | negative declaration from Gerrie Scott on behalf of Citizens for a Cleaner, Safer SOMA |
| 16 | ("Appellant"); and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, This Board of Supervisor's held a duly noticed public hearing on March 29, |
| 18 | 2005, to consider the negative declaration appeal filed by Appellant; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered the negative declaration and |
| 20 | heard testimony, the appeal letter, a responses to concerns document prepared by the |
| 21 | Planning Department and received public comment regarding the adequacy of this document; |
| 22 | and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, The negative declaration files and all correspondence and other |
| 24 | documents have been made available for review by this Board and the public. These files are |
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| 1 | available for public review by appointment at the Planning Department offices at 1660 Mission |
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| 2 | Street, and are part of the record before this Board by reference herein; and |
| 3 | WHEREAS, Since the Planning Commission adoption of the negative declaration, |
| 4 | there is no new information of significance that would require a substantial revision to the |
| 5 | negative declaration and necessitate recirculation of said document pursuant to CEQA |
| 6 | Guideline Section 15073.5; now, therefore, be it |
| 7 | MOVED, That this Board of Supervisors finds that the contents of the negative |
| 8 | declaration and the procedures through which it was prepared, publicized, and reviewed |
| 9 | complied with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Cal. Pub. Res. Code |
| 10 | sections 21000 et seq., hereinafter "CEQA"), the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs. |
| 11 | Title 14, sections 15000 et seq., ("CEQA Guidelines") and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco |
| 12 | Administrative Code ("Chapter 31"); and, be it |
| 13 | FURTHER MOVED, That based on substantial evidence in light of the whole record, |
| 14 | this Board of Supervisors finds the negative declaration reflects its independent judgment and |
| 15 | analysis and is adequate, accurate, and objective, and hereby affirms the decision of the |
| 16 | Planning Commission to adopt the negative declaration in compliance with CEQA, the State |
| 17 | CEQA Guidelines, and Chapter 31. |
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
