

1 [Participate with other California counties in a study to determine the outcomes of Proposition
2 36, including its impact on the drug abuse treatment system.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Treatment**
5 **Access Program, Community Behavioral Health Services (SFDPH, TAP, CBHS) to enter**
6 **retroactively into an agreement, which includes an indemnification clause, with The**
7 **Regents of the University of California, University of California at Los Angeles**
8 **Integrated Substance Abuse Program (UCLA, ISAP), the primary contractor, and**
9 **expend funds in the amount of \$100,000 to participate in a Proposition 36 research**
10 **study, for the period of November 1, 2003 to November 1, 2005.**

11 WHEREAS, UCLA, ISAP is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institute on
12 Drug Abuse (NIDA) for the project titled "Treatment System Impact and Outcomes of
13 Proposition 36 (TSI) Study"; and,

14 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of NIDA, UCLA, ISAP, and SFDPH,
15 TAP, CBHS to participate in this program; and,

16 WHEREAS, UCLA, ISAP has agreed to reimburse SFDPH, TAP, CBHS in the amount
17 of \$100,000 from this award; and,

18 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCLA, ISAP requires SFDPH, TAP,
19 CBHS to enter into a Contract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of
20 the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part
21 of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available funds on program
23 expenditures by not including indirect costs in the contract budget; now, therefore, be it
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1 RESOLVED, That SFDPH, TAP, CBHS is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into
2 a contract agreement in the amount of \$100,000 with UCLA, ISAP, the primary contractor, for
3 services under the "Treatment System Impact and Outcomes of Proposition 36 (TSI) Study",
4 and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
6 indirect costs in the budget of the agreement; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the provision
8 in the Agreement pursuant to which the City indemnifies UCLA, ITAP; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
10 agreement on behalf of the City.
