7	WHEREAS, On October 15, 1855, Saint Ignatius College Preparatory, formerly Saint
8	Ignatius Academy, first opened its doors to educate San Francisco's youth; and,
9	WHEREAS, Saint Ignatius's founder, Father Anthony Maraschi, SJ, carried forth the
10	spirit of Jesuit education laid out in the Ratio Studiorum, a guidebook for the establishment of
11	Jesuit schools first published in 1599 and revised in 1832; and,
12	WHEREAS, On April 30, 1859, the state legislature granted a charter to the school,
13	and Saint Ignatius was officially incorporated under state law; and,
14	WHEREAS, Saint Ignatius has encouraged educational, cultural and moral
15	development; and,
16	WHEREAS, Over the years, Saint Ignatius has educated many great San Franciscans
17	including, the first person to ever fly a glider, John Montgomery; former mayor of San
18	Francisco and U.S. senator, James D. Phelan; famed actor of the 1950's and 1960's, Richard
19	Egan; former mayor of San Francisco, George Moscone; former San Francisco Supervisor
20	and Assembly Speaker, Leo McCarthy, and former governor and current Mayor of Oakland,
21	Jerry Brown; and,
22	WHEREAS, After 135 years of existing as an all boys school, Saint Ignatius
23	incorporated as a co-educational institution; and,
24	WHEREAS, Saint Ignatius has preserved many treasured practices and traditions of
25	San Francisco; and,

1	WHEREAS, Saint Ignatius has fostered civic unity, civic duty and the value of "men and
2	women for others" for many successive generations of San Franciscans and Bay Area
3	residents; and,
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends Saint Ignatius College
5	Preparatory on its 150 years of Jesuit Education in San Francisco.
