

1 [Grant funds to support HIV vaccine trials.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to enter**  
4 **retroactively into an agreement and to accept and expend funds in the amount of**  
5 **\$156,895, with the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center (FHCRC), the primary**  
6 **contractor, to support the San Francisco HIV Vaccine Trials Network (VTN) Leadership**  
7 **Group/Public Health Foundation Enterprises (PHFE); for the period of June 1, 2007**  
8 **through May 31, 2008.**

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10 WHEREAS, FHCRC is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of  
11 Health, National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIH-NIAID) for the HIV Vaccine  
12 Trial Network (HVTN); and,

13 WHEREAS, FHCRC has awarded a subcontract to the DPH – HIV Research Section  
14 in the amount of \$156,895 for the period of June 1, 2007 through May 31, 2008 to support the  
15 VTN Leadership Group/PHFE; and,

16 WHEREAS, This subcontract is one of three from FHCRC for the HVTN project; and,

17 WHEREAS, Retroactive approval is required because DPH did not receive this  
18 subcontract agreement from FHCRC until December 26, 2007; and,

19 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required, as funds support one existing  
20 position, a Chief Medical Director (Job Class #2237) at .50 FTE; and,

21 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the FHCRC requires the City to  
22 enter into a subaward agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk  
23 of the Board of Supervisors in File No.080314; which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
24 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

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1           WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of  
2 \$22,447; now, therefore, be it

3           RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract  
4 agreement and to accept and expend retroactively \$156,895 from the FHCRC; and, be it

5           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend  
6 retroactively the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1;  
7 and, be it

8           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded  
9 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the  
10 agreement expires; and,

11           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
12 agreement on behalf of the City.
