3 **Resolution designating the San Francisco Independent to be the official newspaper of**  
4 **the City and County of San Francisco for the category of non-consecutive day official**  
5 **advertising, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003.**

7 WHEREAS, in each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the official  
8 newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to Article IX, Section 2.80-1 and  
9 2.81 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; now therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Independent, a newspaper of general circulation  
11 published in the City and County of San Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic  
12 news and intelligence of a general character, having a bona fide circulation of at least 50,000  
13 copies per calendar week, printed in the City and County on three or more days in a calendar  
14 week, is hereby designated as an official newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco,  
15 commencing July 1, 2002 for the publication of all official advertising of the City and County  
16 which is required by law, other than the provisions of Section 2.103 of the Charter as they  
17 relate to special meetings of the Board of Supervisors and its special or standing committees,  
18 to be published one time, and all official advertising of the City and County which is required  
19 by law to be published more than one, but not more than three times per week for a specified  
20 number of weeks, and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Contract Administration is hereby authorized  
22 to execute a contract with the San Francisco Independent and said contract must be in  
23 accordance with all the contracting requirements of the City and County of San Francisco.
