17	City and County, may transfer any unused balance or portion thereof from previously	
18	appropriated funds to augment existing appropriations as long as the transfer is within the	
19	same fund and governmental unit. The Controller shall notify the Mayor and the Board of	
20	Supervisors Finance Committee (or any successor Committee) in writing and at least thirty days prior	
21	$\underline{to\ authorizing\ of}$ any transfer of funds made pursuant to this section which exceeds $\underline{10\ 5}$	
22	percent of the original appropriation to which the transfer is made. Any such transfer which	
23	exceeds 5 percent shall be the	e subject of a Finance Committee hearing within thirty days of receiving

notice from the Controller of the proposed transfer. Following any such hearing the Finance

Committee may recommend review of and approval, rejection or modification of the proposed transfer

1	by the Board of Supervisors. Failure of the Finance Committee to conduct a hearing on the proposed	
2	transfer within the thirty day period, or to refer the proposed transfer to the Board of Supervisors for	
3	further review within two weeks of holding the hearing shall constitute approval of the proposed	
4	transfer. No such transfer of funds shall be made to an appropriation which was previously	
5	reduced by action of either the Mayor or Board of Supervisors in their review of the budget for	
6	the current or prior fiscal year.
